

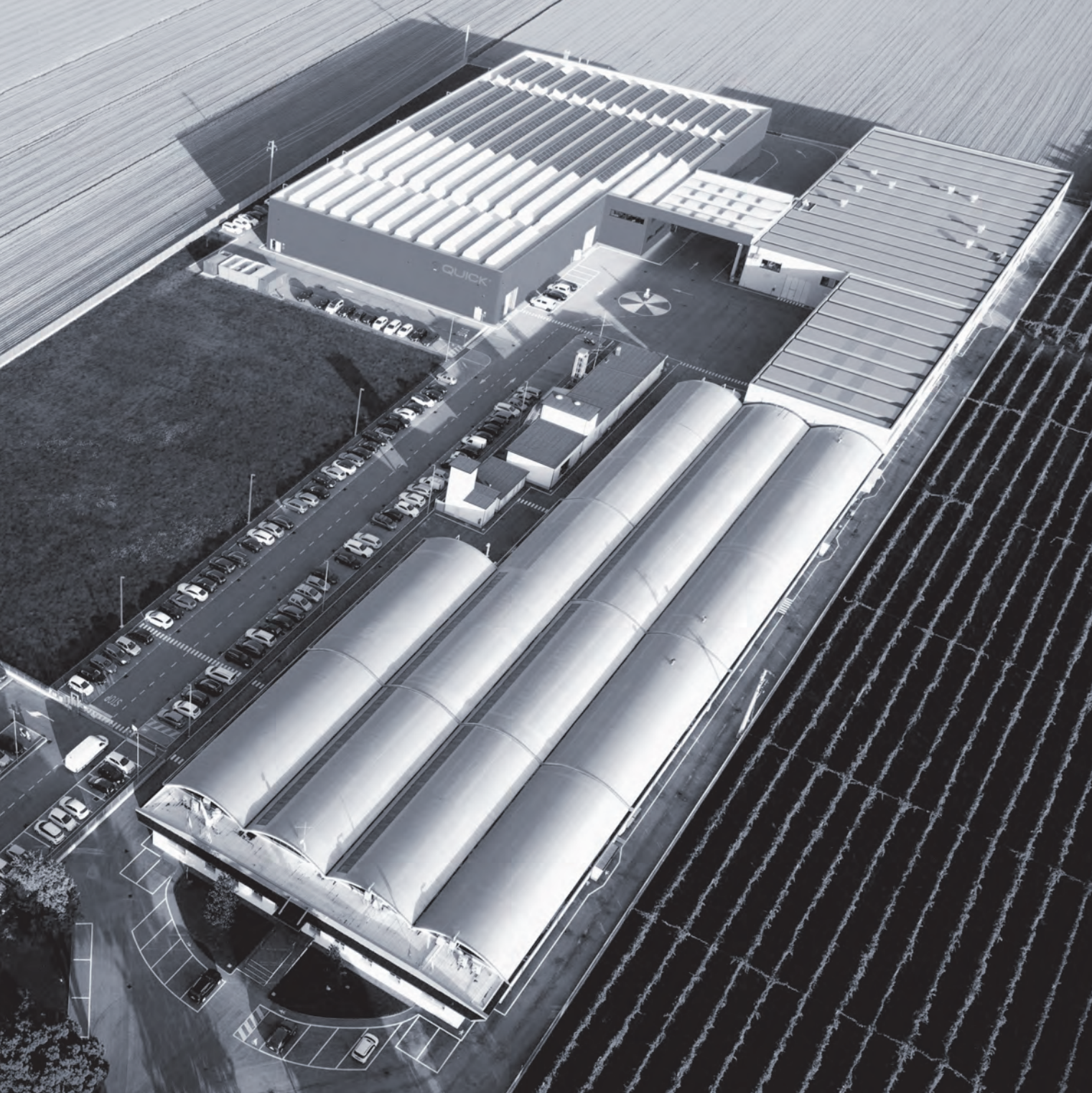

The Group is globally recognized for its product range which includes gyroscopic stabilizers, technical and decorative lighting for nautical sector, up to windlass and anchoring systems, battery chargers, thruster systems, water heaters.

Thanks to recent acquisitions, Quick Group has expanded its product portfolio, also including complex components for super yachts such as ladders, gangways and deck equipment, integrated control systems such as electronic diesel, electric and hybrid propulsion control systems, electronic steering systems with electro-hydraulic actuation, maneuvering systems (also assisted), position-holding systems, stability control systems and remote control and, finally, doors, portlights, hatches, cleats and steering wheels.

The service network of the Group guarantees a worldwide support and innovation: assistance and collaboration are the pillars of the company able to produce over 640,000 products in a year, exporting them globally with more than 110 distributors.

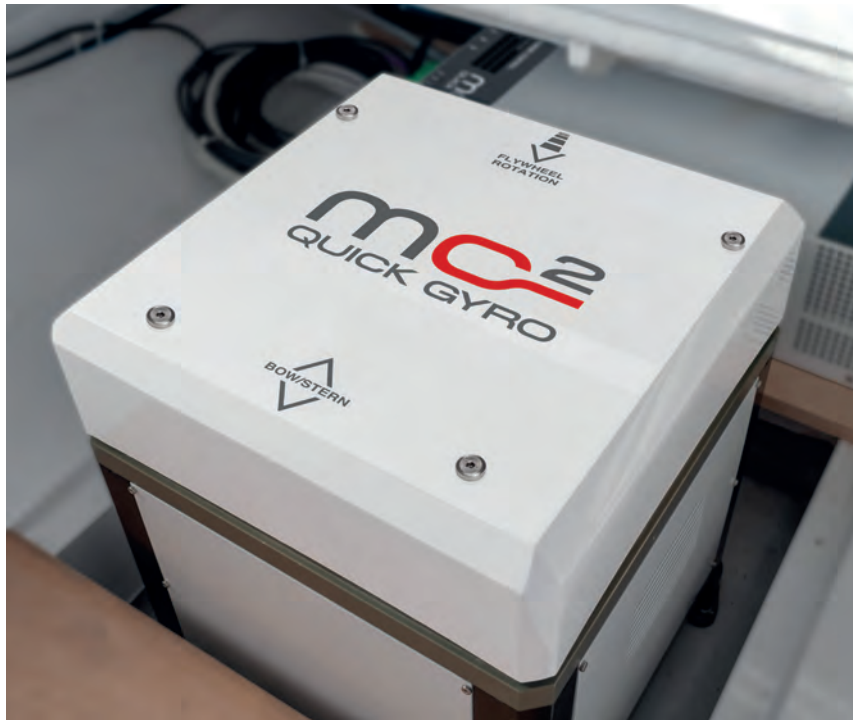
